



# 2018 RECYCLING INFORMATION

# SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING -ALL THE FOLLOWING ITEMS CAN BE PLACED TOGETHER IN RECYCLING CONTAINER PROVIDED BY EXPRESS DISPOSAL

### • GLASS

All container type glass in clear, brown, green or blue coloring. Remove and discard caps. Rinse thoroughly, labels do not need to be removed. No light bulbs, windows, mirrors, dishes, or ceramics.



### • ALUMINUM CANS

**Beverage containers only. Rinse thoroughly.**No aluminum foil, food containers, or pet cans.











## • TIN CANS

**PLASTIC** 

wrap, or syringes.

remain, rinse completely.

All coated metal cans, bi-metal cans, and steel containers. Rinse thoroughly. Labels do not need to be removed.

No cardboard sided cans or aerosol cans.

No motor oil containers, styrofoam, toys, plastic

### • PAPER and CARDBOARD

Newspaper, magazines, catalogs, paper grocery bags, cereal boxes, junk mail, soda cartons. All cardboard boxes, must be flattened and clean.

No wax paper or contaminated food paper (i.e., pizza boxes). No paper plates, paper towels, tissue, carbon paper etc.





Remember, state and local laws require everyone in Wisconsin to recycle newspaper, magazine, cardboard, food and beverage containers, tires, yard waste, appliances, motor oil, lead acid batteries and office paper. Wisconsin DNR Adm. Code NR 502.06
